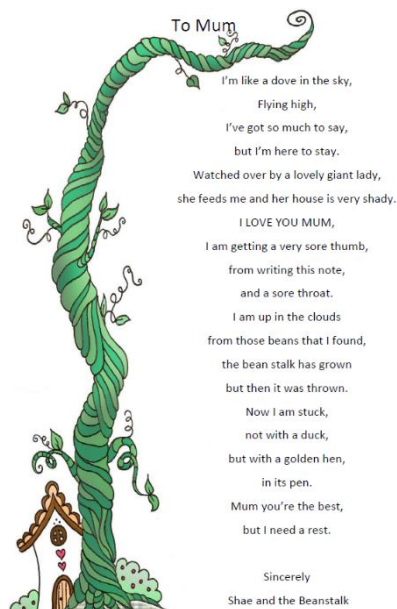
Welcome to Week 6, what a busy couple of weeks it has been.
